Gambling Report:

Julie Prince presented the gambling report from July 2015. A full report is on file for review upon request.

For the month of July. Total pull tab revenue over \$350K. Another great month for gambling sales.

We received a refund from the IRS from payroll taxes overpayment. This is an ongoing process as the IRS reconciles their records. This time it's a refund, other time we are asked to pay more in.

No payment to hockey administration this month.

Needs for September. Asking for \$69,200 for estimated expense. The amount would be \$39,200 without prepaid ice fees.

Discussion to increase prepaid ice amount to \$50k. Motion by Brian, 2nd by Kyle for a total of \$89,200 for expenses. Motion approved 9/0.

President's Report:

Some questions were asked by attending association members.

Q: How do the budget numbers from last June (2014) compare to this June? A: Fees were lower, costs this year have increased. Cash position is dropping. New budget committee has analyzed the budget and has made changes. Feel like the new budget will help stabilize cash position.

Ice hours have increased. Still trying to keep to the recommended ice hours from HOC. Want to keep hours up.

Secretary's Report:

Treasurer Report:

\$173,270.29 in bank. \$10,000 in outstanding checks for a current balance of approximately \$163,270.

Loss fee that was due has been paid. Bank reconcile is done through August.

Currently only credit card registration dollars are going into the bank. Checks from registration will be deposited after the final registration day has been complete.

Kris Holthaus should be designated the Master Administrator.

Motion to approve the treasurers' report by Dan, 2nd by Scott. Motion approved 9/0.



The Board of Directors for BYHA nominates/recognizes Kristine Holthaus as the Master Administrator for the QuickBooks Online accounting service/database we utilize for our accounting software. She has the Title of Treasurer for our hockey association and is deemed responsible for the accounting and treasury function. She is also on the Executive Committee for the Board of Directors for Buffalo Youth Hockey Association.

A: The promotional expense line item provides for participation in the various parades throughout the district include promotional supplies, prizes and various give away items.

SafeSport – All coaches, board members, volunteers associated with teams must complete. Good for 2 years, renew every 3 years. Some may have to renew.

- **Spectator rule new this year. Any parent or spectator getting booted from the stands due to behavior will have serve a mandatory 3 game suspension. State wide, no exceptions.
- **Team slotting due by October 5th final declarations.
- **Scheduling meeting October 10 and 11 in St. Cloud. Bring an assistant.
- **District 5, along with District 3,6,and 9 have come up with Pee Wee AA and Bantam AA League and uniform rules. There are 2 divisions. Northern D5 and D3 (Buffalo, St. Cloud, St. Michael, Osseo/MG, Minneapolis, St. Louis Park, Wayzata). Southern D6 and D9 (Chaska/Chan, Eden Prairie, Edina, Jefferson, Minnetonka, Prior Lake/Savage, Mankato).

Each team will play 2 games home and away within their respective division and one cross over game against each team in the other division for 19 total games. D5 will base district standings on D5 games.
