Athletic undershorts/garter belt— for protection and to hold up hockey socks Optional Equipment: Mouth guard (squirts & under), Neck guard, Skate guards

Skates need to be tied as tightly as is comfortable for your child. Skates need to stay on the black rubber mats to keep the skate blades sharp, which is essential for skating well. If you need to walk on concrete, please wear guards. To care for the blades, make sure they are dry and keep the guards off in your bag. Dressing for hockey usually takes 20-30 minutes. Please take that into consideration and be on time for practice. You can use the lockers rooms here or dress your child at home.
