Be selected to Junior Team Wisconsin (20 players and alternates)

Attend and participate in all Team Wisconsin 2016 functions including:

- Team Wisconsin Training Camp on April 15-16, 2016 in Sun Prairie, WI
- "Pre-NIT" practice on Wednesday, April 20, 2016 in Plymouth, MN
- CCM National Invitational Tournament
