## **Rules and Information:**

- All games will be played at: New London High School, 1700 Klatt Road, New London, WI 54961.
- All games will be governed by WIAA rule:
  - 5-minute warm up before games. 5-minute half time.
  - All games will consist of two, 18-minute running clock halves. The clock will stop for timeouts and the last 2 minutes
    of each half only.
  - Three-point rule will be in effect.
  - Man to man defense only. Pressing allowed last 2 minute of each half, unless up by 10 points or more.
     Pressing allowed during all overtime periods.
  - Free throw line will be standard free throw line.
  - 2 full timeouts per half, 1 timeout in overtime; no carryover in regulation or in overtime.
  - Overtime will consist of 2 minutes with clock stop. If tied after first overtime, a second overtime will consist of 2 minutes with no clock stop. If still tied after second overtime, the 10 players on the floor will shoot free throws. First team to shoot will be decided by a coin toss. If after the 10 players on the floor shoot and it is still tied, the winner will be decided by the first team to score a free throw by alternating shooting with the 10 players on the floor.
  - WIAA referees will be used.
  - 1<sup>st</sup> technical foul will result in an automatic 2 points and the ball for the other team. 2<sup>nd</sup> technical foul will result in ejection from the game whether it is a coach or a player.
  - Please bring your own balls for warm up. Each team must provide a game ball for their games.
- Decisions of the tournament referees and the tournament committee are final without protest or appeal.
- The NLGYBA, its members, and the New London School District shall not be held responsible for personal injury of any player or fan or loss of individual property during the tournament.
- Individual awards for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places (A maximum of 12 per team)
- No carry-ins allowed! Coaches please inform your parents. Concessions will be available throughout the entire tournament
- Daily admission prices: \$4 adults, \$2 students and Senior Citizens, 5 and under free.
