



Rhineland Ice Association Fact Sheet

- Rhineland Ice Association is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization that owns and operates Rhineland Ice Arena. The RIA receives insignificant subsidized funding, therefore our dedication to fundraising events and individual and business support is paramount to facilitate funding of our operating and debt service expenditures.
- RIA has approximately 90 youth hockey players and 30 youth figure skaters participating in sanctioned programs. RIA also has 75-100 Learn to Skate participants and provides public open skate to approximately 100 individuals on a weekly basis.
- RIA hosts 7-8 fall and winter hockey tournaments and a figure skating competition, bringing in 600-700 families that provide 1200-1500 hotel night stays annually. These tournament families spend significant dollars in hotel rooms, food, gas, and other merchandise sales in the Rhineland area.
- RIA is home to a spring hockey program with more than 70 participants.
- RIA has largest indoor concert/banquet venue in the Northwoods. Annually hosts concerts, circuses, benefits, and other entertainment events that bring people to Rhineland.
- RIA is home to Rhineland High School Boys Hockey and Northern Edge Girls Hockey.

Board Level Signs - The best place to advertise in an ice arena is on the playing boards at the ice surface level. Everyone watching the action will see these advertisements throughout the course of the event. The RIA offers 5 year and lifetime board sign agreements. Board signs are 8 feet long by approximately 3 feet high and are full color and full graphics.

5 years—\$4,000

Lifetime—\$10,000

Arena Signs – These signs line the walls of the ice arena. Visible during all events at Rhineland Ice Arena. Signs are 4 foot high by 8 foot wide. Full color and full graphics.

Year 1 - \$300 (includes manufacturing)

Renewals \$175 annually

Home Tournament Sponsorship – Helps local teams host tournaments in Rhineland. RIA hosts 5-7 Tournaments per year. Your business will be recognized in tournament program and announced throughout the tournament.

One Tournament - \$100

All RIA Tournaments \$400

High School Game Sponsorship – Your business will be recognized as a sponsor at all home boys and girls high school games for the entire season (announced over the PA system).

Season - \$500
