b. Will be playing both $8^{\text {th }}$ and $7^{\text {th }}$ grade tournaments $-7^{\text {th }}$ grade tournaments would be supplemented with $6^{\text {th }}$ graders as needed.
2. Motion made and seconded that going forward to use dollar amounts per grade level rather than number of tournaments.
