President's Report- Greg Gibson: WYHA received a check for \$552.50 from Kelly Lyman for the Derek Campbell Memorial Fund. On November 9, GGibson will present a check for \$7,973.00 to the City of Plymouth for 10 new mite nets and dividers and the cost to update a gate on PIC A to accommodate the new equipment. Treasurer's Report- Tim Jewell: Presented October report. The cash position and registration dollars are up from last season because registration is up. WYHA is in a good financial position going into the season.

Marketing — Greg Gibson: Total Hockey has agreed to provide equipment again for the First Stride program next fall. "Try Hockey for Free," which was scheduled for November 7, 2015, has been cancelled.

Tournaments- Mike Nispel: WYHA will host 5 tournaments in the 2015-16 season. The first tournament will begin on November 11, 2015. All of the tournaments are nearly full for the season. More information will be forthcoming on the Jr. Gold playdowns.

Registrar – Greg Gibson: Jr. Gold and Mite Registration remains open at this time. 1,022 players registered to date. This is ahead of last years registration numbers.

Safesport – Greg Gibson: No report.

BlueLine — Ruth Allen: The medical kits were distributed and the handout went well. Positive feedback was received about the new packaging. Sponsorship has been sold for 18 mite teams to date. Volunteer hours are going well to date. WYHA has a new relationship with Buffalo Wild Wings in Plymouth. More information on this to come in the future.
