Financial Update from Aimee Kinkade: \$55,000 in CD
\$194,000 balance in checking since year is just beginning, and all bills paid to date.
Travel team assessments will go out at different times this year so not 1 big bill. \$250 due by Nov 1st.

Lucky Leprechaun has gone on for 3 years so need to see where money is from those years. Aimee will give update at next meeting. In 2011 \$10860 made.

Also Board would like a profit/loss statement for IYHL and can use fiscal date from July 1 to June 30th.

Learn to Play update: program running well with help of Mike McNeill and his staff, and Donanvan Haugstad and Chris Sandas at IB, and Pete Gillin sending out communication to the parents.

Aimee Kinkade asked about putting a team together for Hockey Time tournament. After much discussion it was decided that kids in fall camp that want to try out will be evaluated by Mcneill and haugstad and Sq and PW teams will be picked to play if enough kids want to.
