POSSIBLE METHODS TO PRESENT THE SPORTSMANSHIP AWARD

THE FOLLOWING ARE TWO POSSIBLE METHODS TO MAKE THE PRESENTATIONS OF THE MHSA / STOCKMAN BANK SPORTSMANSHIP AWARD FOR A GAME. YOU MAY USE ONE OF THESE OPTIONS OR USE A PRESENTATION OF YOUR OWN (PLEASE SHARE ANY OTHER OPTION YOU MAY USE WITH US).

- Present the award for a player on your team from the previous game at the beginning of the game – possibly a minute or so before the introductions. If the winner were from the opposing team – give the medal to the coach before he/she leaves so the medal can be presented to the athlete before the next home game.
- 2) Present the award after the conclusion of the game as the teams are shaking hands have the announcer announce the winner(s) of the Sportsmanship Award and present the medal at this time.

(Before the game)
