- Tim Roessler
 - o Make a couple comments in regards to the Bantam team action item. Heard that there would only be one team. I think we would do a disservice to these kids by not having 2 teams. I think there are too many players for one team. All the kids have worked hard and have always had 2 teams. Looking back at the March meeting it was decided then to have 2 teams and looking back the numbers haven't changed. A lot of kids registered thinking there would be 2 teams. It states in the policy manual that if there is over 20 players on a team we would have 2 teams.

o I want to address the Bantam action item. I honestly believe that we should keep it at 2 teams and we have so many kids that have worked so hard to get to this point. If we are talking about JV and Varsity equal playing time I totally get that but were talking about Bantam. These kids have all been playing together since ponies I think we owe it to them. We promised them we would have 2 teams at the WHA Banquet. We announced there would be a Bantam A and B2. All the kids worked all summer shooting pucks based off that philosophy. As parents, we paid our fees off the philosophy we would have 2 separate teams. To find out about it at the last minute, if we would have know this sooner some of us could have made other arrangements. We could go to Owatonna, Mankato so our kids could still see the ice time. I have a kid that is on that bubble. Last year played on the B team. If you look at their numbers they have huge improvements in their skating and skills because they spent so much time on the ice, not just doing drills. Do live action game situations. If we go to 21 players were not going to have that. Last year we saw in my opinion the 3rd line get very little game time so if we have a 4th line what realistically will happen with them. They could also be late bloomers. We have great examples, Michael Jordan who got cut as a sophomore. Andrew Burnett who played on a C squad as a Bantam player and now is a pretty good hockey player for the Wild. He accredits his coaches keeping him on the ice doing those drills. Coaches can't start pin pointing and separating kids out. Plus I think we have to stick to our word. We lose creditability with parents and the community by not keeping our word. Were always told to support the WHA but we ask that you support it by keeping 2 teams. Now not to just stand up here and talk about it, Scott Hansen and myself would step in and coach the B team even if our kids weren't on it. Also in the policy manual, pg 18, it talks about having 2 teams if over 20 skaters. It does state board approval but were asking you to stick to the policy of having 2 separate teams. It also says in the manual about equal playing time to not do a disservice to the kids by having some players play more than the others.

Rate for Skill Session for HS Girls / 14U:

I would recommend we charge each player \$50 for the year.

Coaches Volunteer Hours:

- It can be difficult to find coaches plus they put in more than 30 hours
- I would recommend they do not have to do the 5 extra hours.

Skill Session Helpers:

- Again it is very difficult to find 4 helpers for each session twice a week.
- I would recommend skill session hours can go towards non concession hours and concession hours.
- They must get their hours only if they work both sessions that given night.

HS Girls Jersey's

- Kyle will speak
- Please add the girls HS jerseys to the meeting agenda for Sunday. Will request \$6,000 for girl jerseys. This is from the same company as the boys ordered from last season.
- 25 jerseys X \$118 X 2 sets (whites & darks) = \$5,900
- We are going to hold off on ordering socks at this time.

Bantam Team:

- It is recommended by Bantam Coaching Staff and WHA Coaches that the Bantams have one "A" team.
- I recommend we have one Bantam "A" Team
- We back and support the WHA coaches decisions
- We're moving to an "A" program and these are the tough decisions we have to make sometime

<u>Details:</u>

- We have 21 skaters and 2 goaltenders
- The District will allow the WHA to Roster 21 skaters up until the District Tournament
- Coach has not seen all the players but feels he has three lines at this time that can compete at the "A" level. (Which is different from last year)
- More lines will give the players a better chance to remain competitive throughout the game...especially later in the game.
- Past Coach / Coaching Coordinator and Youth Skills Director feels this is best option.
- No equal playing time at bantams
- No other coach

Multiple Options for Players / Parents:

Option 1:

- Allow any player to practice, participate in skills at a reduced rate of \$300
- If parents choose to continue to pay full rate.....player has a chance to continue to compete for a playing position

Option 2:

- We roster all players who paid full fee
- There is no guarantee a player will play during a game.

• At District Tournament time three players will be cut from tournament roster.....they still will be able to practice with team.....

Option 3:

• Release any player that would like to play for a "B" team in another association

Option 4:

Full refund

Parents must notify the Bantam Coach and WHA President if they choose Option 1, 3 or 4 by October 15th and there will be no tryouts.
