

MHS Baseball Booster Club General Meeting, Feb 16, 2015

Meeting called to order by Dennis at 7:02pm.

Dennis noted we have two people who stepped up to co-chair concessions: Jana Osborn and Ruth Covin. We are up and running. Sign Up Genius has been sent out. Thanks for patience with schedule changes and we still have slots open. May add slots for scoreboard on Sign Up Genius.

Coach Sherman:
