2016 GIRLS PLAYER DEVELOPMENT CAMP

Thursday, March 17th through Saturday, March 20th at Arcadia Ice Arena

The complete camp schedule is included with this letter and has been posted to the AAHA website at www.azamateurhockey.org

The Arizona Girls Player Development Camp is open to all girls who are members of USA Hockey and born in the following birth years; 1999/2000 (17/16); 2001 (15) and 2002 (14). Under USA Hockey guidelines, Girls must be US Citizens and residents of the State of Arizona in these birth years in order to be eligible to be chosen as an Arizona representative for advancement to the Girls Multi-District Player Development Camp. This year's Arizona Camp will have three (3) ice slots encompassing power skating, skills development and skills/scrimmages sessions. Goalies will also receive a "Goalies Only" session, combined with boy's goalies, on Wednesday, March 16th at Arcadia Ice Arena.

The primary focus of the camp is skills and fundamentals development of the individual player. The Camp also serves as an evaluation and selection process of players in three age groups, 2002's, 2001's and 2000's/1999's combined, to represent the State of Arizona at the Girls Multi-District Player Development/Evaluation Camp. The Multi-District Camp will combine girls from the Rocky Mountain District, the Pacific District and the Northern Plains District at one Camp on the campus of Colorado College in Colorado Springs, Colorado. The dates of the 2016 Girls Multi-District Player Development Camp are June 11 – 16, 2016. Players will live in dorms along with the coaching staff for training and education and will be similar in structure to a USA Hockey National Camp. Girls with birth years of 1999, 2000 and 2001 will also be evaluated for the opportunity to advance to USA Hockey's National Player Development Camps in their respective age divisions later in the summer. Frequently Asked Questions about the Girls Multi-District Player Development/Evaluation Camp has been posted to the AAHA website under the Player Development tab, then the 2016 Camp Registration tab .

As has been the case for the past several years, Arizona will be bringing in at least two outside evaluators. Together, they will be responsible for the on-ice skill development and scrimmage sessions as well as the selection of girls to advance to the Girls Multi-District Player Development Camp.

The cost of the 2016 Arizona Girls Player Development Camp is \$130.00 per Player thru March 11th, \$145.00 after March 11th.

Registration for the 2016 AZ camp is now open thru www.azamateurhockey.org

Players selected to attend the Girls Multi-District Player Development/Evaluation Camp will be responsible for paying an additional fee of \$675 for the camp which will include the player's room and board. Players selected will be notified of registration and payment procedures by the District. The Arizona allocations, as received from the District, for the Joint Camp are: 4 forwards, 2 defensemen and 1 goalie per age division.
