**RYAN
MARTIN**

Ryan Martin was born with Spina Bifida and both of his legs were amputated at the age of two. Discovering basketball at 12 years old transformed Ryan's world from "wheelchair bound" to bound for college, for professional basketball, and for traveling overseas. In 2007, Ryan joined the professional basketball league in Spain, playing as a point guard for CID Casa Murcia Getafe in the last four seasons.



Before Ryan went pro, he attended college at Southwest Minnesota State University and led SMSU to the NWBA National Title Game in 2001. He graduated in 2002 with a degree in Secondary Education with a minor in Sociology. After graduation, Ryan joined the Phoenix Wheelchair Suns and played in the 2005 NWBA All-Star games.

Along with establishing his foundation, Ryan is a program coordinator for the Hospital for Special Care mentorship program, and has been a counselor at the Ivan Lendl Sports Camp.



DEREK KLINKNER

Derek Klinkner is in his third season on the SMSU coaching staff in 2014-15 and is in his second full season as head coach. He started the 2012-13 season as an assistant coach before taking over as head coach in February.

Klinkner also played for the Mustangs from 2010-14.



A native of Artesian, S.D., Klinkner was a member of the SMSU football program for three seasons, earning all-conference honorable mention honors as a sophomore in 2009. Klinkner is a 2012 graduate of SMSU and also received his master's degree from SMSU.
