



## Recreational Ice Time General Information

### Parking

- Parking is not provided and is the responsibility of each participant. The RiverCentre parking ramp is directly accessible to the facility via skyway. They do charge \$10.00 prepay parking all day. The Science Museum also has a parking ramp close by and other small surface lots within a 1-block radius. The City of St Paul also has parking meters located on the streets surrounding the facility.

### Entrance

- All participants are to enter Gate 1 located on the South East side of the building on Kellogg Boulevard. Check in with the security staff located in the main lobby. Security will direct participants how to get to the dressing area.

### Releases

- All persons skating must present or sign a release in order to participate. Any participants under 18 must have a parent or guardian signature.

### Locker Rooms

- Access to locker rooms will be granted no more than 30 minutes prior to your scheduled start time.
- Locker rooms are located behind the player's benches. All dressing rooms have restroom and shower facilities. There are no towels available. Please discard trash before leaving. With other activities in the facility, please vacate the locker room area as soon as possible.
- **Minnesota Sports & Entertainment and the Saint Paul Arena Company are not responsible for lost or stolen articles. Please do not bring valuables into the facility. Keys to locker rooms will not be issued.**
- Skate sharpening or pro shop items are not available at the facility.

### General Rules and Policies

- Any spectators accompanying skaters must remain in the seating area and not roam the facility.
- Scoreboard use is not available for recreational ice time.
- The facility does not provide pucks or cones.
- The user is responsible for any damages occurred to the facility during their use of ice time.
- **Helmets are required if participants are playing hockey.**
- There is no First Aid or medical staff available during recreational ice time.
