

BABE RUTH/CAL RIPKEN FEQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: I have questions regarding Babe Ruth and Cal Ripken baseball in West Fargo, who should I contact?

Q: Registration is closed, what do I do now if I have not registered?

A: You may contact Gerald Urlaub and go through our late registration process. His email address can be found under the [Contact](#) section of the website.

Q: What are the fees for Cal Ripken/Babe Ruth?

A: Ages 7-12 - \$120, Ages 13-15 - \$140. Everyone is also required to complete the fundraiser. Details on the fundraiser are found in the registration or within the Fundraising section on your website.

Q: When will practices start?

A: Practices are determined by the coaches. Field availability plays into this as well. We expect that most teams will start practice around the end of April or beginning of May.

Q: What days are practices?

A: Practices are determined by the coaches. Most teams will practice 1-2 days per week. The exact days and times of the practices are up to the coaches. Field availability also plays into this as well. We have found that most coaches do not opt to practice on the weekends, but ultimately that decision lies with the coaches.

Q: When will games for BR and CR start?

A: Games will begin around the second or third week in May depending on the age of the player.

Q: When are games played?

A: Game nights are subject to change depending on the number of kids that sign up for each age. No regularly scheduled games will be played on Friday nights for any ages. Game nights for 7-12 YO are TBD and will either be M/W or Tu/Th.

A: Travel sign up and tryout times will be announced by West Fargo Baseball after registration via the website and email.

Q: When will the player draft take place?

A: The exact date varies from year to year, but it will be March/April.

Q: How do I know what team my child is on?

A: After the draft has taken place, the coaches will be notifying the players that are on their respective teams in April.

Q: When is the parents meeting?

A: This will take place in April. A firm date has not been finalized, but it will be posted on the website and emails will be sent out notifying you of the date.

Q: Where should I check on the website for BR/CR information?

A: Information that pertains to the entire BR/CR program will be posted on the Babe Ruth page. While we may at times post information to the home page as well, this will not be the standard place for you to look for information. We do encourage you to check both the home page and the Babe Ruth page for news and information.
