2016 Border Battle Rules

Electronic or paper waivers must be turned in before first game
Players may only be listed on one roster per age division
Birth Certificates or USA Registration will be checked to match roster/waiver form
Home team will wear light colors

Game Information

Teams must be ready to play up to 15 minutes prior to scheduled game time 5 minute warm up period

Tag up off sides will be used, otherwise all USA hockey rules will be used

Checking at the 2002 level only

Three (17) minute stop time periods

1 minute break between periods

Ice will be resurfaced every 2 periods for 2005 birth year and older

Running time will be enforced with a 6 goal lead

The Clock will not stop during running time

Each team is permitted one 1 minute timeout per game

Championship and Third place games will go to a 5 minute overtime and then a 3 person shoot out if tied at the end of overtime

Pool Play

Two points for a win and one point for a tie

Teams will be seeded by the number of points they accumulate within their pool

Tie breakers

Head to Head

Goal differential - 7 goal max per game

Least goals allowed

Highest total goals scored

Least penalty minutes

Coach and Player conduct

Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their players on and off the ice Coaches are responsible for making sure their locker room is clean before they leave
