As a Coach Pitch Coach you're main goal is to have each and every player walk away at the end of the season being able to say they had a fun and memorable season and learned the basics of softball. This includes but is not limited to:

- Being able to identify where first, second, and third bases are and when to stop and run through a base.
- Batting procedures including: where to stand in the batting box, the correct way to hold the bat, proper placement of hands, following through on a swing.
 - Understanding and being able to identify the difference between a strike, ball, and a foul.
 - Not only knowing where all infield and outfield positions are, but being able to run to their position with little or no assistance.
- Players will be instructed on how to throw and catch a ball including grounders, pop flies, and player throws that incorporate fun and exciting activities.
 - Special attention should be paid to team spirit, sportsmanship and teamwork.
 - Positive-ness and encouragement will be practiced.

Each coach will be provided with an assistant coach, and will have the support of fellow coaches and the director. Also, a practice plan, which you can see an example of below, will be used. Prior to the start of the season coaches and assistants will attend a coaches meeting where policy and procedures will be discussed. In addition ideas and coaching experiences will be traded and any questions you have will be answered.
