

Policy: Non-CPYSL League/State Cup/Tournament-Only Fee Reimbursement

Effective Date: August 1, 2016

Purpose:

This policy is to detail league/State Cup registration fees and referee fees Fusion F.C. will reimburse to teams opting to participate outside of the Central Pennsylvania Youth Soccer League, registering for State Cup play, or opting for tournament play only in lieu of league/cups during a season.

Fusion F.C. is a member of the Central Pennsylvania Soccer League (CPYSL) and participates in this league. Fusion pays for all team registration and referee fees for teams who participate in CPYSL league play. Player registration fees are set by the Board based on current expected CPYSL fees.

Teams may opt to play outside of our established League or to play in State Cup competition or tournament-only play in lieu of CPYSL league play. For teams playing in a non-CPYSL league or state cup play in lieu of CPYSL league play, Fusion will pay for or reimburse a team for a team's registration fees and referee fees up to the amount of the same season's established team and referee fees for CPYSL (i.e. if the cost to register a team with CPYSL is \$100.00 and a team would play 8 games during a season with each game's referee fees being \$21.00, a team would be eligible to receive up to reimbursement of \$100.00 toward their team registration and up to \$21.00 per game for up to 8 games). Teams are only reimbursed for referee fees for the actual number of games played (i.e. if a team plays 3 State Cup matches, the team is only reimbursed for referee fees for those 3 games). Players on teams who opt for "tournament-only" play for the entire soccer year pay a reduced registration fee; for these teams, Fusion pays for EPYSA team fees and direct player fees. "Tournament-only" teams are not eligible for any reimbursement of referee fees.

Requirements:

A team must submit documentation to the club of payment if requesting payment or reimbursement (cancelled check, receipt, or other documentation of team fee due/paid; documentation of games played). Non-CPYSL league referee fees may be requested prior to the start of the season based on scheduled number of games. State Cup referee fees must be paid upfront by the team and then reimbursement requested, as number of games is dependent on how far a team advances in Cup play.

A team who participates in CPYSL play AND State Cup during a season is not eligible for reimbursement for State Cup fees. Teams are only eligible for one type of reimbursement per season non-CPYSL play (Cup OR non-CPYSL league).
