




The facility is 1/4 mile from Interstate 75 at exit 333 in historic Dalton, GA.

- Volunteer Organizations Grindhouse Wrestling School, Dalton State College Athletic Department, Dalton High School Wrestlers and Boosters, Northwest Whitfield High School Wrestlers and Boosters, Southeast High School Wrestlers and Boosters, Cohulla Creek High School Wrestlers and Boosters, Morris Innovative High School Wrestlers. (All these organizations have agreed to provide mats, table volunteers and support to help run the tournament including scales for weigh-ins.)
- **Volunteer Table Workers** We have 26 committed adult volunteers with wrestling backgrounds to help manage the 13 tables/mats and work with the local high school volunteers. None of these individuals have youth wrestlers that would be participating.
- **Security** City of Dalton and County of Whitfield will provide uniformed officers for the event and parking. The Trade Center has barriers that will be used to secure the mat areas like never before. (Photo in later slide)
- **Electronics** Dalton High School will prove **13 Laptops** to be used at each scorers table with WiFi to run the event <u>live on Track</u> and on flat screen televisions within the facility to keep wrestlers and coaches up to date on where matches are on each mat in live real time.
- **Food** There will be multiple points of access for fans for concessions. Food will be traditional event food plus smoothies and can customize based on what team georgia wants to serve.
- **Hospitality** This will be a special box/room that overlooks the main arena with a back door that is on the up stairs floor to provide easy access to the 3 mat 6u room. There will be a very wide variety of nice food and drinks available for all. We can also customize based on needs of team georgia.
- **Healthcare** Hamilton Medical Center will provide one EMT Unit on location and a trainers table incase of any injuries and to help handle nose bleeds and other incidentals.
- **Vendors** We have to ideas for vendors in the halls or we can use a banquet room/vendor round to not crowd the walking areas.

#### Plan


**Weigh-Ins** - 5 to 8 pm (doors <u>will not</u> open early) Advance tickets sales (all family members must be present to get the family rate) Bonze Card Passes will be handed out at the same time. There will be a morning option from 7 to 7:30. There will be 6 scales used (2 per age group) and 3 check weight scales. We will run this in the upstairs ball room to control entry and exit for the kids safety and organization. This is the same room that we will run all 6U on 3 mats.

**Mat Plan:** Each of the 13 mats will have a corner with a Red Carpet Triangle and a Green Carpet Triangle. There will be two chairs on each piece of carpet for coaches to sit and coach their wrestler. Coaches will sit on corresponding color to their wrestlers band and only two coaches will be allowed per corner.

**Building Organization:** All 8U & 10U will be in the main room with 10 mats. We would run all 6U in the upstairs ballroom on the 3 mats. There is a 250 seat auditorium to run coaches and referee meetings.

**Finals/Medal Rounds:** We would run all finals on 6 mats in the main room and expand seating capacity as we shrunk the number of mats to over 2,000. We could bring down the lights and have music and smoke to bring the wrestlers out to. really make it a professional show for them.


**Medal Awards:** During the finals we would organize the upstairs ball room with the platforms and awards. We would bring each age group to the ballroom at one time to control the mass of people and make it easier on parents and coaches to see, hear and take photos.






# 10 Mat Arena Layout


Approximately 1800 seating capacity.

All 8u & 10u matches and Medal rounds




# 3 Mat Ballroom Layout
