Motion to approve the March Minutes motion by Julie Ann, seconded. Motion passed.

Gambling Report by Tracee deNeui - Report attached.

Motion to approve the monthly report; approval for expenses for May 2016 in the amount of \$56,250; approval to make an Ice Time payment to ACYHA in the amount of \$20,000; approval to pay the City of Plymouth their first quarter taxes in the amount of \$3,819.95. Motion to approve by Tawnia, seconded. Motion passed.

Julie Ann raised the question that we approved the monthly report for the previous month without actually seeing the report. We did not resolve the issue as it is currently about timing. Buck suggested to table to exec.

### Chairman Report Scott Graul

State of the Club Report - Our number has increased after many years of decreasing. We have also set a goal of improving our brand and we have had successes. We also set a goal to grow girls hockey and have had a good increase. We had good luck with the 5 "Try Hockey for Free" events and the marketing signs have helped. We added a U15 Girls team and they went to State. This is our second year of Junior Gold and has been successful. Thank you to Jay and Lisa for their hard work in supporting these goals.

More players added to the ice challenges; Mark has worked hard to find us ice and is doing things to keep increasing our options. New Uniforms this year were very exciting and we got great feedback; thank you to Kirk for his hard work. Thank you to Buck for running the December 3-on-3 tournament, we had over 100 skaters and the kids had a great time. We also did a new event - Junior Goal Alumni event — we have about 80 skaters, so we think we will do this again.

We have been working hard on process improvements and adding roles to make our process work more smooth, including the new Evaluations Coordinator; thank you to Catherine for taking on that role. We also now have manuals for all board members; thank you to Julie Ann for that. We are adding an Assistant Treasurer and this is another way we are trying to deepen our bench.

We had a good year with Dryland. Thank you to everyone for all the hard work.

<u>Balloted Elections Nominations Report by Crissy Ginther</u> - The nominating committee put forth the slate of: Chairman - Buck Humphrey the outgoing Vice Chair; remarks made. This would be a three year term with full hours compensation.

Vice Chairman - Jeff Pappas new to the board; remarks made. This would be a three year term with full hours compensation.

Scott called for nominations off the floor, hearing none we will move on to the bylaws.

<u>Bylaws Update Secretary Julie Ann Schmidt</u> - We have a number of bylaw changes for approval by the membership. They were approved by the board last month, unanimously.

Administrative changes - Changing Player Development Committee (PDC) to Hockey Development Committee (HDC), Section 5.1 updating the asterisks on the compensation (noting changes, just improved the wording to be more clear, Typos)

Policy Changes - Changing the Registrar from a voting board member to a non-voting member, so we are following the MN Hockey rules as we have been out of compliance; adding a definition of HDC; changing the attendance wording in Section 5.4 (c)

Questions were raised about why the Evaluations Coordinator was not listed as a non-voting board member; the reason it is not listed is because it is not a board position.

Distribution of Ballots - Congratulations to Buck Humphrey as our new chairman and Jeff Pappas as the new Vice Chair. They are instilled tonight and will step into the role in May.
