  - c. Fundraiser Income generated from Kickoff Card Sales \$11000
  - d. Continuing to pursue Signage sponsorships There are 3 new signs at BBC
  - e. \$540 income from game concessions: 2 Basketball, 1 Football
  - f. \$700 income from Player packs
  - g. \$1400 income from sales of extra Baseball hats/pants/t-shirts; Julie suggested we have the rest of items for sale at the Banquet as summer teams could use extra items
  - h. Coach Bus expense to Grand Rapids Varsity/JV games cost \$500; Eric to see if school will cover more; Eric suggested pre-ordered food for ride for the next game- Deanne volunteered to get Subway forms and order.
- 2. Team Assignment / Development / Training

  - c. Determine how many kids to expect so a cost per person can be determined Julie & Mike chose Italian buffet at \$15.99/person but will determine if there's a minimum food order to defer room rental fee and how much to charge each person to cover cost. Coaches & Managers won't be charged, Then Diane will send email invitations for families to print and mail back.
