



2016 PAFA “Player Drop” Refund Policy

Due to the extensive growth of the PAFA program and the number of volunteers necessary to operate the multiple aspects of the program, PAFA needs to have a firm player drop policy. The intent is not meant to cause undue difficulties for those that choose to drop from the program, but by the dates outlined below, uniform and equipment expenses have already been made. The following drop process will be applied for the 2016 season.

From the start of registration up to June 24th:

- All monies will be refunded less a \$50 administration fee.

From June 25th up until July 21st:

- 50% of all monies paid are refunded (less a \$50 administration fee).

From July 22nd through end of season:

- There is no refund available.

- All drops must be completed by contacting Tanya Tyska directly at tyskat@yahoo.com
- You must also notify the PAFA board ASAP with your intent to drop. Go to www.palatinepanthers.com for email contacts.
- If the player was issued equipment, deposit checks will be refunded by the PAFA Treasurer (only if all equipment was returned in its entirety).
- If the drop occurs during the season, special arrangements must be made for the return of the equipment. The appointment for return can be arranged through your level's Division Administrator.
