

 - Separate location for T-shirts and/or hats





Umpire Crew

- Area Tournaments
 - Selected and paid by TD
 - (recommend selecting a Chief and have them select their crew)
 - Chief Umpire rotates crew
 - All names must be verified by Department
 - (submit names to Eric soonest)
- State Tournaments
 - Selected and Paid by Athletic Committee
 - Crew Chief is responsible for assigning daily from provided list of qualified umpires (may rotate)




• Accommodations for the attending umpires should be made in conjunction with the Umpire in Chief well in advance of the tournament, provide a suitable private dressing and break area for your umpires. If you have a camper or trailer available, your crew will appreciate it. An airconditioned unit should be considered.



Umpire Crew cont.

- Assign person/team to provide water/towels and check on crew during game
- Provide between game a location that is away from crowd/stands/major traffic area
 - Cool area / changing area / snacks and liquids
- TD is ultimately in charge of umpires / if not present, identify the person Chief needs to consult for protests have Committee #'s on site



Umpire Crew cont.

Tournament Directors and the designated Chief Umpire must exercise common sense in assigning umpires to games. Relatives of coaches or players shall not umpire in that game. When the host team is playing, make every effort to schedule an umpire other than a local to work the plate. Tournament Directors, district chairmen or team managers shall not serve as umpires. The chief umpire shall be ultimately responsible for crew assignments unless otherwise agreed upon between the chief umpire and the Tournament Director. Coaches shall have no input as to umpire assignments relative to who works which position.



Finance Committee

Park

- EMTs at park or on call

 - ❖ Recommend that local law enforcement be, at a minimum, informed of the tournament dates offer free burgers or hotdogs for them to stop and visit



Nebraska American Legion Baseball - 2023



- Give time for Managers/Coaches to make corrections of the missing or incomplete items of the Coaches book (Notify Area Rep)
- Penalty: Head Coach is suspended until deficiencies are corrected.
- Brief the penalty at Seeding meeting.



- At the seeding meeting that is the last time a team can protest the legality of a player from another team
- If there is a protest, TD should immediately contact the Area Rep or Chairman
- Team making the protest must do so in writing



- Get whole packet w/photo of winner to the State TD (find a way to email digital team photo)
- All Tournaments will follow provided Brackets
- Return provided Bracket to Department HQ as soon as your seeding meeting has been completed (or before if you have your times set, I can preload bracket)
 - It is important to get these in ASAP (call it in, takes 10 minutes)



Area Tournaments cont.

- Note 1&2 on 7/8 team bracket go back to "earliest played" against in bracket
- If necessary, game no coin flip, home and away switch, dugout change optional
- Send Pitch Count to the State Tournament Director.

*Unbelievable as to how difficult that was last year



- Note about Game Changer being used
- Can use it but not for Official Book that should still be the paper/book kept by the assigned official record keeper
- State and Area TD's do not need to do the background check or Child safety training.



State Tournaments

- Tournament Directors should coordinate with local hotel/motel in the area to ensure availability of rooms for teams that will be needing them. TD's should reach out to teams with a list of hotels/motels to contact. State TD's should plan on availability for all 7 teams for the first 3 days of play, utilizing the Form 1 roster size of 18 players and 2 coaches, 4 players to a room and 2 rooms for coaches.
- State Tournament Directors will coordinate with Area Tournament Directors and provide information and instructions as to the schedule and activities of the State Tournament for Junior and Senior Area Tournament winners. Area Tournament Directors will pass along these instructions to Area Tournament winners immediately upon completion of each championship game.



Game Time

- Follow Bracket
- Higher seeded team will be Home team in first game, after, coin flip will determine Home team
- Must play National Anthem before EVERY game. US Flag will be flown
- All Protests will be filed with the TD who will contact an Athletic Committee member for Disposition (get your \$50 first)



Game Time cont.

- All suspended games will be completed from the point of suspension (Pitching is affected)
- Any double headers not authorized by the bracket will need approval by an Athletic Committee member (most likely will be caused by weather and may be needed to finish the tournament in time to get the CH to the State Tournament)



Points of Concern or Changes

ALB Rule R. Pitching Rule. No player may pitch more than a total of 105 pitches per day. A pitcher will be allowed to finish a batter if he reaches or exceeds the maximum limit during an at-bat, but must exit the position after that hitter. No player may enter the game as a pitcher without having fulfilled the required rest days as mandated in the chart below. No player may make more than two appearances as a pitcher during any consecutive three-day period.

PENALTY – The pitcher is removed from the pitcher's position and head coach shall be ejected from the game and serve an additional game suspension.

A day is defined as 8 a.m.to 8 a.m.

Day 1 pitched 80 in 10:00am game does not mean can pitch Day 2 in 1:00pm game Pitches Day 1 rest is Day 2, can pitch on Day 3



Points of Concern of Changes

ALB Rule R. Pitching Rule cont......

Any player may be removed from the pitching position and remain in the game at another position. However, a pitcher will be automatically removed from the position when a coach makes a second trip to the mound in the same inning, and that player cannot return as a pitcher in that game. PENALTY — Forfeiture of the game if a protest is filed with the umpire-in-chief before the last out of the game.

Admin note: "last out of the game" is in National Rule book NALB states: protest of an officials call during a game: must be filed before the next pitch (see 6.08b)

- If a player returns as a pitcher in the same game, he will be charged with another appearance.
- If a team has multiple games scheduled on the same day, a pitcher who pitches more than 45 pitches in Game 1 may not pitch in a subsequent game that day and will be required to follow the rest protocol listed.




Points of Concern or Changes

NALB Rule 1.03 PLAYER ELIGIBILITY:

(d) Any appeal to a player's eligibility must be submitted in writing or by approved electronic means and contain quantifiable information to dispute the eligibility. Anonymous appeals will not be honored.

Admin Note: Although it is preferable to submit the protest well in advance of the seeding meeting, per Rule 5.02 - The seeding meeting will be the last point to question or protest a player's eligibility except in a case of age eligibility. Penalty for ineligible player carries a minimum 2 game suspension for the head coach – players suspension is at the Chairman's discretion. Do not confuse this with rule 3.05 as that is a separate rule.






Points of Concern or Changes

NALB Rule 1.11 DUAL ROSTER PLAYERS:

Coaches may dual roster Junior players onto the Senior team, not to exceed the roster limit. A Junior player that will be a DR player must be listed on BOTH the Junior and Senior rosters that are submitted and are required to be in uniform and available to play for a minimum of **8 Junior regular season games** to participate in Junior post season play. Deadline for dual roster of players is June 15th. Once Junior Post Season Tournaments start, Junior Players are locked into the Junior Program until eliminated.






Points of Concern or Changes

NALB Rule 1.12 DUAL PARTICIPATION PLAYERS:

Refer to Rule 6. D of the national rule book. A player who has been authorized to participate in other baseball organizations MUST be in uniform and available to play for a minimum of **8 regular season games** to participate in post season play. Dual Participation must end at the start of post season, players cannot participate on any other baseball team/league.






Points of Concern or Changes

NALB Rule 2.03 MERCY RULE:

- (a) **15-Run Rule:** after 2 1/2 innings if the home team has the last at-bat or 60 minutes. All teams will use this for regular season and Area Tournaments. Class A Juniors, Class B & C Juniors and Seniors will also use for State Tournament.
- (b) **8-Run Rule:** after 4 1/2 innings if the home team has the last at-bat. All teams will use this for regular season and Area Tournaments. Class A Juniors, Class B & C Juniors and Seniors will also use for State Tournament.
- (c) **10-Run Rule**: after 4 1/2 innings if the home team has the last at-bat. Class A Seniors (only) will use at State Tournament in lieu of 8-Run Rule.






Points of Concern or Changes

NALB Rule 2.08 DESIGNATED HITTER:

All levels will adopt the NFHS DH rule throughout the regular season. Class A Juniors, B & C Seniors and Juniors will continue to use the NFHS DH rule for Area and State Tournaments. Class A Seniors will revert back to the ALB/MLB DH rule for State Tournament.





Points of Concern or Changes

NALB Rule 2.09 COURTESY RUNNER / RE-ENTRY:

- (a) NALB will allow courtesy runners for the pitcher and catcher for all games except for Class A Senior State Tournament. The courtesy runner may run for both the pitcher and catcher of record but not in the same inning. The courtesy runner may be used as a pinch hitter or pinch runner after their time as a courtesy runner has ended. Refer to ALB Junior Rule 1.G for clarification.
- (b) NALB will allow re-entry for all starting defensive players and the starting DH for the entire season with the exception of the Class A Senior starting with the State Tournament.



Points of Concern or Changes

NALB Rule 4.04 PENALTY:

Any player, coach or manager ejected from an American Legion Baseball game will result in:

- (a) During **regular Season** and **post season** tournaments any conduct by players, coaches or managers resulting in an **ejection** are suspended for the remainder of that game must leave the ballpark area and will also serve a **Mandatory** one game suspension (7.E National rule). Department Athletic Committee members may increase the length of the suspension if the situation warrants. Suspensions must be served starting with the next playable game following the ejection unless reinstated by the Department Athletic Committee Chairman. While serving these suspensions Coaches or Players will not be allowed in uniform or in the dugout to include: pregame warm ups and coaching via signals, cell phone or another communication medium.
- (b) All suspensions carry over to the following games, if suspended during the regular season and the next game(s) will be during the post season, the suspension will be enforced during the post season. If suspended during Area Tournaments, the suspension will carry over to State Tournaments if needed. If the ejection takes place during the final game of a programs season, the suspension will carry over to the following season should the individual be eligible to participate.
- (c) **Malicious Contact:** During regular season play the Athletic Committee may impose a longer suspension period depending on the severity. During Area and State tournaments, the player is automatically removed from the remainder of the Area or State Tournament (unless that player is reinstated by the Department Athletic Committee.)
