Cliff Sell made a motion to approve May 2023 BBSC meeting minutes and Ken Snyder seconded. All were in favor. May 2023 meeting minutes were approved, motion carried.

#### FWSA Convention -6/15-18/2023 @ Grove Hotel and Boise Center – Lynda Clark:

- Lynda went through itinerary for convention, which is available on FWSA Website and attached as page 5 of these minutes.
- Everyone from Board that is attending is registered.
- 120 people currently registered for convention.
- BBSC will set up booth at Silent Auction Friday night, Steve is updating display board with
  pictures and info on Greenwood Scholarship program and QR code. Steve made a motion to
  spend \$50.00 on supplies needed to update display board. Nancy Moore seconded. All were in
  favor, motion carried.
- Steve Strickland being recognized as "Volunteer of the Year"
- Additional activities include Wednesday- Ansots Basque restaurant, Thursday-bike ride, rafting trip, and pub crawl; Friday- 16<sup>th</sup> Annual Michael German Memorial Golf Tournament and Day on the Mountain.
- Board members attending as delegates and being paid by BBSC are expected to attend all meetings.
- Diane Ross, Marketing Director, has been busy contacting television and radio stations, and newspapers to promote upcoming FWSA convention.

• FWSA funding for Vertigals will be donated to Idaho Youth Ranch. Due to changes in leadership with Vertigals, Nancy Moore made a motion to donate \$250.00 to "Jason Folton Memorial Fund". Sherri Lechten seconded, all were in favor, motion carried. Monies raised for this fund are used to help children with hemophilia.

## **Italy Trip- Jeffrey Rosendin**

Trip to Italy that was tentatively planned for 2/23/2024-3/10/2024, including six days of skiing in Dolomites and stays in Rome, Florence and Venice, has been deferred to 2025. Alpine Adventures was requiring deposit of \$15,000.00 by June 8, 2023 (in two days). That is about half of the clubs operating budget. There was a motion to spend \$15,000.00 of BBSC funds for the deposit for trip for 2024. The motion was not approved. The Italy Trip will be deferred until 2025.

#### **Bike and Barge Tour- Nancy Moore**

 Bike and barge to Bruges Belgium, proposed for April or May 2024. Margie and Paul helping Nancy. Nancy made a motion to proceed with trip planning for Bike and Barge to Amsterdam.
 Steve Strickland seconded, all were in favor, motion carried.

## Treasurer's Report: Ken Snider

- IRS update- Ken talked to Eric (Jeff Beebe's son) after last months' meeting in May. Eric said that the IRS application is now filed, and we should get a reply from IRS soon. Ken also verified BBSC address with accountant. Ken is still waiting on that response as of June meeting.
- Ken provided updates and financial statement and activities for the month of May to the BOD prior to meeting via email dated 6/4/2023, which is summarized as follows:
  - Membership revenue this reporting period was \$354.28 (down slightly from last month)
  - Annual meeting expenses (\$2075.80) exceeded sales, BBSC had loss of \$1017.85.
  - The end of season tailgate party on 4/30/2023 at Bogus Basin generated small surplus of \$136.03.
  - o BBSC paid \$1790.00 to Board representatives to participate in FWSA convention.
  - FWSA reps that attended BBQ at Barbara Bryant's donated \$300.00. Expenses were \$170.00.
  - Net balance of operating account is approximately \$26,636.44 (down from last month).
  - Christine Hill made a motion to approve May Treasurer's Report; Sherri Lechten seconded; all were in favor. May 2023 Treasurer's Report was accepted and approved.

#### **Communications: Sherri Lechten**

- Currently we have about 230 members in BBSC. Those that were part of old membership database will auto renew, not certain if new members entering in new registration system will auto renew.
- Currently our BBSC email mailing lists are not working properly, our domain expired on June 5. Not everyone is getting emails. Carol is working on new email list.

• Sherri made a motion to switch our domain address from Go Daddy to Square Space. Cliff Sell seconded, all-in favor, motion carried. Sherri will work on immediately.

#### The Mogul: Carol Peterson

• Carol still publishing monthly issues of the Mogul. Since Carol is taking on more responsibility, Board suggested maybe publishing less frequently.

Marketing: Diane Ross not present, working on outreach for FWSA (see discussion there)

#### Social Media: Nancy Moore

 Have about 2500 followers on Facebook. Nancy reminds us that it's not about the words, but the pictures!

He is on the board as assistant director to help with board meetings and board sponsored activities and needs to be able to get to activity locations, even when there is not a board member available to offer a ride. Carol Peterson made a motion to provide \$200.00 per year for Jordan's transportation to attend and assist in BBSC events and activities. Nancy Moore seconded. Motion carried.

#### **2023 FWSA Host Council Remuneration**

Following, is a proposed remuneration agreement for the **Intermountain Ski Council and Bogus Basin Ski Club** to host the 2023 FWSA Convention. The payment for Silent Auction Walk-Ins remains at \$3.00 for any walk-ins up to 100; \$5 per walk-in over 100. For Registered Delegates over 200, there will be a \$3 payment per person to better match Convention attendance in recent years.

\$100 or \$75	Finders Fee for Local Silent Auction Vendors	Based on <i>net price of the sale</i> of the item(s) donated: \$100 paid for over \$250 / \$75 for under \$250
\$400	Expense Reimbursement for Suite Parties / Events	Intermountain Ski Council & Bogus Basin Ski Club to purchase all liquor, beverages, and food for parties:  Friday evening FWSA Suite Party, Saturday evening FWSA Suite Party, Sunday morning Eye Opener Party – TOTAL ~\$300*.
