

East Texas 3v3 Futbolito Tournament

Tournament Check-in Check List

Special Events – (an event that does not follow typical soccer rules, for example 3v3, 4v4, etc.)

Since there is no “official rosters” for special events and players can come from any sequence, below is a list of what you need for player registration verification. The key point to remember for special events is that you have to verify to the tournament that the player is currently registered, which in return means they are covered under the insurance policy of a NTSSA sanctioned event. If they are not registered, a special event registration form and a \$5.00 fee will allow them to play.

	<p><u>Official Rosters:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ NTX Players – roster must be signed by association’s registrar, team coach, and be the current soccer season. ➤ USClub Players – same as above, fully executed USClub roster <p>Example - 5 players all from different teams, you can provide each players official team roster for player registration verification. Or all players are on the same team, just use official roster.</p>
	<p><u>Guest Player Forms:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ NTX players – form must be completely filled out with all proper signatures and player ID number. ➤ USClub – player loan form with all proper signature and player ID number. <p>Example – 5 players, 3 on same official roster (use roster), 2 on different team (use guest player forms)</p>
	<p><u>Academy Player Registration:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ NTX – a player’s current academy registration form signed by players association’s registrar and has the player ID number can be used for player registration verification. Also classifies as medical release. <p>Example – 2 players on same official roster (use roster), 2 academy players (use academy forms), 1 player not on roster and no academy form (use guest player form)</p>
	<p><u>Non-Registered Special Event Player Form:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ There is an additional \$5.00 fee for this form, per event. It MUST be accompanied with the player’s birth certificate. It allows players not currently registered anywhere to play in this special event as a registered player. <p>Example – 2 players on same official roster (use roster), 1 academy player (use academy form), 1 player not on roster and no academy form (use guest player form), 1 player never played before nor registered to a team (use special event registration form)</p>



Check off the items, that apply to you, to help you insure you have completed it.

Items to bring with you to Check-In (All teams)

	<p><u>All original paperwork:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Any and all combinations of player registration verification as described above.
	<p><u>Medical Releases:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ All players attending have to be accompanied with a medical release. They do NOT have to be notarized. Academy player forms double as a medical release form.
	<p><u>Sit-Out Verification Form:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Every team must bring four copies (2 per page/so only print out twice) to check-in for validation.
	<p><u>Player Identification:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Not required, but VERY STRONGLY suggested. Every player should have either a Player Card and/or a copy of their birth certificate. Should tournament staff request a player’s identification these will be the only acceptable forms of identification.
	<p><u>Game Cards:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ You will be notified when you can print your game cards. You will need to print all three games and ALL THREE MUST BE VALIDATED at check-in before the referee’s will allow your team to take the field.
