

FINISH LINE WORKERS

1 Track Judge – has final say over placings; will coordinate who picks places

2 Finish Line Coordinators – record the data after the races; will help pick & time if needed

5 Finish Line Assistants – duties as assigned by Track Judge and Finish Line Coordinators

Not all people will be needed at all times. Track Judge WILL stay the whole time; Finish Line Coordinators and Assistants can switch off as need be.

- The **HAND TIMING** is done for all races; using one main printable timer.
- The **PLACINGS** for the **100m, 200m, 400m, 800m, 1500m, 3000m, 4x100m relay and 4x400m relay** are completely YOUR responsibility.
