1 Track Judge - has final say over placings; will coordinate who picks places
2 Finish Line Coordinators - record the data after the races; will help pick \& time if needed
5 Finish Line Assistants - duties as assigned by Track Judge and Finish Line Coordinators
Not all people will be needed at all times. Track Judge WILL stay the whole time; Finish Line Coordinators and Assistants can switch off as need be.
$>$ The HAND TIMING is done for all races; using one main printable timer.
