The Cassidy “Cup” Tournament

The tournament begins with a “qualifying round” during our preseason games for Divisions I , II, III. The Masters will only play in the finals. This actually means 4 separate “cups” -- **Each division would play in its own tournament.**

Purpose:

To perpetually honor Joe Cassidy’s memory and service to our league and the players who started with him

To allow each division to have its own tournament therefore involving all of our competitive divisions and players of equal abilities.

To involve all of our sponsors in the activity by issuing a commemorative plaque to the winning sponsor in each division.

Tournament Guidelines

Preliminary Round: Each Division's preseason games will make up this qualifying round. **Division Finalists** will be the top two qualifiers for the division as determined using the following criteria, in order, until any "tie" is broken:

- a. Each team's preseason win/loss record (3 games)
- b. Head to head competition
- c. Highest run differential (runs for – runs against) (3 game totals)
- d. Simple coin flip done by the commissioner.

(Any exception to this process is at the discretion of the Commissioner)

1987 - Joe Cassidy organizes a group of softball players, ages 35+ as the “Senior Mixed Softball League “. Three mixed teams were formed to play teams from the Eastham, Orleans and Brewster fire departments. Games were played at Nauset Regional High, Volunteer Field, Orleans, Chatham High School and Potter Field, Harwich.

1988 – Senior Mixed Softball League officially changes its name to Cape Cod Old Timers Softball League. Weekly practices were held at Potter Field, Harwich, Kelley Field, Dennis and Brewster Field, located in front of the Brewster Town Hall.

- * As the League expanded, Joe Cassidy would accept ten players applications annually (55+) and assign them to teams as needed.
- * Mid Cape Door was an original sponsor of the League (1987) and continues their sponsorship today.
- * Jerry Hachadorian, Bud Rose, Bill Winnett and Joe Cassidy were some of the original members of the League

1988-1991 Joe Cassidy was elected as the first Commissioner of the League. He administered the League independently without a Board of Directors, Officers, by-laws or other forms of governance.

1992 - Maynard Simpson assumes the duties as the League's second Commissioner.

1992 – 2013 Joe Cassidy was an active player and participant in League affairs into his nineties.

2015 – The Cape Cod Senior Softball League hold its first annual “Cassidy Cup” to honor Joe and the players that formed our League.
