2017 North American Indigenous Games (NAIG) CHAPERONE VOLUNTEER APPLICATION

The Manitoba Aboriginal Sports & Recreation Council (MASRC) is now accepting applications for **CHAPERONE** *volunteer* positions. Positions are available for various sports held at the 2017 North American Indigenous Games. The NAIG will take place in Toronto, ON July 16-23, 2017.

The MASRC is the recognized Province/Territorial Aboriginal Sport Body (P/TASB) that oversees the operations of Team Manitoba. Team Manitoba will be comprised of approximately 420 athletes, 80 coaches/chaperones and 20 mission staff.

CHAPERONE POSITION DESCRIPTION

In conjunction with MASRC staff, Sport Managers and coaching staff, the chaperones will participate in supervision and guidance of athletes attending the Games. Chaperones are required to abide by the policies; rules and regulations; and other guidelines handed down by the MASRC, the NAIG Council and the Ontario 2017 Host Society.

GENERAL ROLES & RESPONSIBILIES FOR CHAPERONE POSITION

Pre-Games: Assist coaches with chaperone duties at practices, camps and events Game-time: In partnership with the coaches/managers, 24/7 supervision of the athletes is required. This means you will be with the team at all times during the NAIG event. The chaperone in partnership with the coaches/managers will also be doing perimeter and bed checks at curfew.

Post-Game: Written evaluation of 2017 games experience will be required.

CRITERIA

- Must be at least 20 years of age when application is submitted
- Must be of good character
- Must be physically fit (Ability to stand for long periods of time, walking long distances)
- First Aid/CPR an asset
- Valid Driver's License an asset

Preference will be given to Chaperone's of Aboriginal decent (First Nation, Métis and Inuit)

The selected Chaperones will be given a Team Manitoba Jacket, T-shirt and Hat! All Accommodations, Transportation and Meals will be provided for the event if selected.

Ratio of 5-6 athletes per supervising adult. The team will be flying to Ontario.

Tryouts (North/South) for most sports have been completed

After tryouts, Coaches have identified and notified their top 20-30 athletes and the final

teams will be selected by October 1, 2016

Athletes must be attending school to be eligible (attendance of 80% required)

Athletes must sign a code of conduct when they are selected to the team. Behaviour and

internet posts will be monitored

Fees:

Athlete fees will depend on the final number of athletes that we take to the games. We of course are aiming at taking the full 420. The estimated cost is \$1800-\$2000 per athlete.

Fees/charges have to be paid to the HOST, the airlines and clothing supplier long prior to the event. We have set up a payment plan for the athletes that will need to be followed so that we have the funds to pay the bills.
