

Freestyle Etiquette

Do not get on the ice till Zamboni doors are shut. Get off ice on time!

- 1. PLEASE KEEP MOVING! STANDING STILL DURING A FREESTYLE SESSION MAY RESULT IN AN ACCIDENT. TALKING SHOULD BE DONE BY THE BOARDS. **REMEMBER THIS IS A TRAINING SESSION, NOT PUBLIC SESSION**. BE ESPECIALLY CAREFUL IN THE LUTZ CORNERS (all 4 corners).
- 2. All skaters must check in at the front counter. Be mindful of your time and don't get on early, and get off when your time is up.
- 3. Must be passed Basic 6 to be on freestyle without your coach, and even then, you must be very aware of everyone.
- 4. **BE AWARE OF OTHERS AROUND YOU**. Skaters/Coaches must be cautious and aware of other skaters and their jumping patterns (spins in the middle, jumps on the ends). Please be considerate of skaters working on field moves or other patterns.
- 5. The skater wearing the colored sash and doing their program has the right of way. This must be worn during busy sessions (10 or more).
- 6. Bring water, music, and anything else you might need to the session with you. Please take everything with you after the session. All trash (tissues, water bottles, etc.) needs to be dispensed of properly in a trash can.
- 7. Music will be played in the order in which it is placed in the box. **Skaters in a lesson will have priority**. The skater may play their music once per session or until all skaters have had their music played.
- 8. Parents may watch skaters in the bleachers or in the lobby. The bench at the side of the rink is reserved for coaches & skaters only.
- 9. All must be respectful of everyone on the ice. Coaches and skaters will be treated with respect. Any problems please bring attention to management.

Continued violation of the etiquette can result in not being allowed to skate on freestyle.
