Presidents Report

MeAHA T4 Proposal:

CB will have 8 SQ T4 teams. No real need to play other organizations. MeAHA proposal to create a northern and southern divisional schedule not appealing as it would cause excessive travel for T4.

Marketing Fundraising update:

- · Dunkin Donut Mug Program will be our main fundraiser again this year. Have two parents assisting with planning and organizing. Goal will be to sell 3,000 mugs again this year. Consider offering donations now for possible prizes for top sellers. (Sea Dog tickets, Patriots tickets, Bruins tickets, Apparel, etc.)

Scheduling:

Midget Travel league game schedules are complete, with the exception of securing a couple of hours outside the normal times I had allotted. Midget teams are finalizing tournaments so there will be some reschedules. I communicated with U16 T2 this am and it looked like a tournament they were looking at would complete their 20 required games. I need to confirm the same with U18 T2 and U16 T3.

Chris P helped me get the new master started and he is uploading games.

There has been a push from a couple of organizations to schedule Squirt through Bantam travel early, people started asking in July. In order to keep the entire process orderly, I am trying to get tournament dates from travel teams firmed up and get the ice plan laid out. I expect to move to travel scheduling in the next week or so. Most of the organizations are in the same place I am.

Midget house ice is secured. I need to know whether there is interest in scheduling Midget Tier IV state-wide. Also, once we know team numbers and names I will work with Tom C to schedule and get them loaded.

I have girls info from Scott M that I am in the process of loading into the master.

I saw an email regarding CB tournaments, as soon as we have info on what weekends we are holding tournaments, please let me know so I can reserve ice in the master.

Finally, I need to know who is scheduling early season skills or any other ice outside the season work so that I can make sure I get that in the master. We use our master to match up invoices from the rink and budget so everything needs to be in it.

Scheduling will hold ice on MLK weekend for a tentative CB Tourney. T4 will tentatively do a Holiday tournament.

Mites

- -Would like to start Evals the week of Sept 26th during mid week with plans to start regular season after Columbus day.
- -Website has been updated. Still need to include coaching requirements and total cost of Mite program.
- -Most head coaches already identified. Waiting to see how many kids register as we might have to have more than the normal 8 teams. Already talked with Scott R about the possibility of sharing ice if necessary.

Arena Update (John V.)

- · Shoulder season lax league went very well
- · Street hockey had a lighter response
- · Used NGIN for signups. Registration fees went right to the CB bank account
- · Arena budget right on track during the hockey season
- · Current on all bills
- · HS preseason skills scheduled; Kent Hulst and Kristin Andrews will run this
- · Ice goes in last week of October
- · CB punch cards will run again in '16-'17. Midgets will have ice allocated instead of the cards.
- · New banners are up at the Arena.

Travel Director Report

- · SQ T2 has only 4 total teams including CB. 18 games against 3 teams.
- · Uniforms ordered

Coach admin/ACE Director:

- As of this afternoon, 20 coaches have registered with CB. New form seems to be working well. No issues reported so far. All coaches must have up to date safe sport certification for this upcoming season to complete the registration form so we will be 100% compliant going into the season. Age modules and level certification will be ironed out once I have the list of coaches from division directors in the fall.
- · I need the list of midget coaches very soon and any other divisions/teams that start early to ensure that they can be rostered in advance of the season.
