## Football Program Policy

- On-field behavior/attitude/effort
- Inappropriate Language
- Attendance/tardiness to all team functions
- Off-field behavior/actions in connections with athletic office policies
- Compliance with team rules

## Athletic/School Policy

- School/class attendance
- Chemical/Behavioral violations
- Athletic code of conduct violations
- Off-field/community issues

\*Each situation within the Spartan program will be conducted on an individual basis following the appropriate guidelines with the best interest of the student/athletes. The head coach in connection with the Mayo athletic office will have the final decision on each individual situation.
