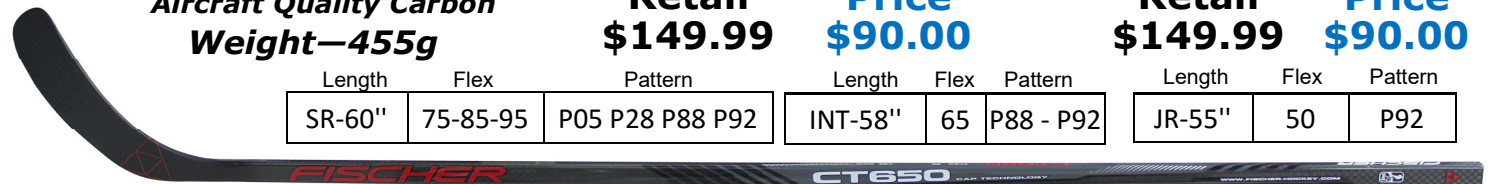

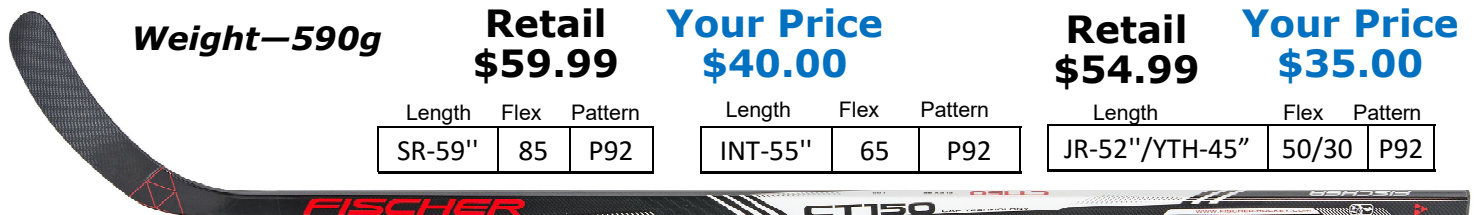

European Manufacturing—All Fischer Hockey sticks are made in Fischer’s own European factories with Carbon Composite Technology direct from the Aeronautics Industry w/sister company Fischer Aircraft Carbon Composites, FACC.com

Spear Shaft Technology—Unique ‘concave’ design creates a stronger shaft for increased durability and a more natural feel in the hands.

Vacuum Tech— Shared with the Ski and Aircraft production, Vacuum Tech is a manufacturing process that decreases the amount of air trapped in the mold to increase resin saturation completely throughout the stick. This technique produces a lighter, stronger, more resilient hockey stick that will not lose its flex or ‘snap’ and will last longer under extreme circumstances.

Cap Tech— A Fischer exclusive also borrowed from Ski production. Cap Tech utilizes a foil ‘cap’ around the entire stick, effectively sealing the carbon fiber material, reducing the effects of cuts and nicks on the carbon surface.

All Carbon Senior Sticks are 60” long, and they have a MID FLEX POINT.

All models have a tactile GRIP to enhance control of the stick.
