Code of Conduct for Parents

The Alexandria Area Hockey Association (AAHA) has established guidelines/principles of parental conduct expected of all participants involved with Alexandria youth hockey.

The purpose of this code of conduct is to ensure that everyone keeps AAHA hockey in proper perspective. AAHA's purpose is for the enjoyment, growth and development of our youth. Our expectation is that all participants take pride in being a Cardinal and consistently exhibit respectful, civil, professional conduct during practices and games and that the Alexandria community is proudly represented and all participants are treated respectfully.

Therefore, the following expectations must be adhered to by parents during games and practices at all times, in the Runestone Community Center and all other rinks visited during AAHA events:

- My child is involved in organized sports for their enjoyment. I will encourage and support my child's desire to play hockey. I will remember that the game is fun and I will not embarrass my child by yelling at players, coaches, fans, volunteers or officials.
- I will support and promote Fair Play by encouraging my child to play by the rules. I will display good sportsmanship by applauding a good effort by both teams in victory and defeat, and respecting players, coaches, fans, volunteers and officials at every game.
- I recognize the importance of volunteer coaches and will take the time to attend team meetings to get to know my child's coach's expectations and guidelines. I will let the coaches do the coaching and will not coach from the sidelines.
- I will not bad mouth other players, coaches, coordinators, committees or the board of directors. I will express any concern through the proper channels in a respectful manner.
- I will not use any profanity or any form of harassment towards others in the arena, locker rooms or team functions.
- I will respect the rights, beliefs and property of others and will treat others with courtesy and respect.
- I will be fully responsible for my own actions and the consequences of those actions.
- I understand that it is a privilege, not a right, for my child to play youth hockey.
