Indoor Winter Rec Soccer at Adrenaline Sports Center in Ramsey

During the long, cold Minnesota winter months our recreational soccer program moves indoors and provides an opportunity for participants aged 4 years through 6th grade to learn and enjoy the game of soccer in a fun, safe and structured environment.

No Prior Experience Required: Our focus is to provide a positive environment for all children, while offering opportunities for motor skill development, exercise, social interaction and above all, an unprecedented fun soccer experience playing with friends.

Learning: Participants will learn the fundamental skills of soccer; dribbling, passing and shooting, through structured activities, fun games and scrimmages. In addition to having a great time playing soccer, children will develop social interaction and communication skills. From improving the pull back to working on an inside hook or feint, players will focus on individual core soccer skills and have an opportunity to put those skills into practice with their team.

Session 2: Must register by Jan 12 to qualify for the early bird deadline and receive \$25 off the cost of registration. Jan 31 is the final day to register for Session 2.
