To be eligible for the recognition the student-athlete must include:

- 1. Copy of current cumulative high school transcript.
- 2. One letter of recommendation from a teacher, coach, mentor or principal that best captures why this student athlete deserves to have this recognition of Academic All American. We ask that this person has direct knowledge of the applicant's academic performance or extracurricular activities. We also ask that the person writing the letter of recommendation not be related to the applicant.
- 3. Dr. Timothy J. Nugent found the NWBA to provide opportunities to people with disabilities. The NWBA asks applicants to do a project to create awareness about wheelchair basketball and the NWBA that will hopefully lead to new opportunities for people with disabilities.
