## Zimmerman Basketball Tournament Rules

We play by MN State High School Rules except where modified and stated below:

1. **Lineups:** Must be submitted 5 minutes before the game. Five (5) minute warm up can be adjusted at the official's discretion. Three minute half time.
2. **Official Score Book:** Score keepers provided.
3. **Length of Game:**
  - 5<sup>th</sup>- 8<sup>th</sup>: Will be (2) 14-minute halves of stop time.
  - 4th grade will be (2) 20 minute, running time halves. Stop clock the last two minutes of the second half if within 10 points.
4. **Running Clock:** The clock will continue to run if a team is ahead by 20 or more points in the second half, and will resume stop time if the lead falls below 10 points.
5. **Time Outs:** Each team is allowed three (3) time-outs per game. Time outs are not carried over into overtime. Each team will be granted one time-out for each overtime. Time outs will be one minute in length.
6. **Overtime:** First period will be two minutes. Second period will be sudden death. A jump ball will start each overtime period.
7. **Defenses:** All defenses are allowed.
8. **Full Court Pressure:** Not allowed if your team is ahead by 20 or more points. No full court pressure in 4<sup>th</sup> grade.
9. **Protests:** No protests will be considered. The referees on the court will settle all disputes. The referee's decision is final.
10. **Players:** Players are allowed to play on one team only.
11. **Three Point Shot:** Three points will be allowed where the floor is so marked.
12. **Bonus Free Throws:** One and One will occur when one team reaches (7) team fouls per half. Double bonus will occur when one team reaches (10) fouled per half.
13. **Technical Fouls:** Two points will be awarded along with the possession of the ball.
14. **Grace Period:** A grace period of 5 minutes will be allowed for your first game of the tournament. All other game times are subject to change. Games may start early, so have all players ready 20 minutes prior to the games scheduled time. Brackets posted at the site are the official brackets. Please check often.
15. **Pool Play:** Winner will be determined by the following criteria:
  - A) Head to Head Match up
  - B) Point differential (points for vs. points against)
  - C) Total Points
