

Parent Code of Conduct

The electronic signature provided during registration acknowledges understanding and agreement to the details within this document.

- I acknowledge that the rules and guidelines set forth in the Codes of Conduct are not exclusive, and that other incidents, language or actions not specifically mentioned therein may subject Players, Parents or Coaches to disciplinary action which may include dismissal from the program without a refund.
- I acknowledge that violations of the Codes of Conduct or other incidents, language or actions not specifically mentioned therein may result in written or verbal warnings against further rules violations, suspension of participation in games and practices on a short term or long-term basis, or expulsion on a permanent basis. All decisions and consequences will be determined on a case by case basis.
- I agree to abide by all decisions and consequences imposed by the respective youth sports group named above with respect to violations of the Codes of Conduct, including decisions related to my future participation or attendance at games or practices at Warren Township Park or sponsored events and games elsewhere.
- I agree, as the Parent or Legal Guardian, to abide by all decisions and consequences imposed by Warren Township Cheer and Pom with respect to violations of the Codes of Conduct, including decisions related to my athlete's participation/suspension in games, practices or attendance at Warren Township Park or sponsored events and games elsewhere.
- I will ensure, as the parent/legal guardian, that my athlete(s) understand the rules, guidelines and codes. I will also ensure they understand that there may be disciplinary action taken should the respective sport administrator(s) deem it necessary for any infraction.
- I agree that in the event Warren Cheer and Pom is billed for a videotaping violation by the IRCA and I or my family members are the person(s) who are identified by the IRCA as breaking the no videotaping rule, I/we will reimburse WTCP the amount of the fine incurred within one week of the bill being issued. Failure to do so will immediately remove my child from the remainder of the competitions for the season and/or Priority Registration for the next season.
- I agree that Parents/guardians are not allowed to confront a coach, team or official to discuss any "negative" competition or practice situation with the coaching and coaching staff until at least 24 hours has passed from the completion of the competition or practice.
