Equipment:

- A&P is a long time supporter of CYH. It's a local business that provides the best value for our budget and offers a 2 week turnaround on jerseys.
- Midget Wrap, Midget Independent, Bantam Travel, Peewee House, Squirt Travel, and Squirt House were ordered and delivered and have transitioned to the new style.
- Team managers will begin the collection process, request money to be collected by 12/15.
- Peewee Travel and Bantam House are going to wear the old style for 16-17 season.
- Mites will continue with Maroon Jersey- through A&P. Jerseys will be delivered by 11/18/16.
- The Board appreciates the understanding and patience as we transition back to a local, reliable jersey supplier.
- Losing pucks- 200 lost in 1 month. Board decided to stop giving candy for a returned puck.
