Boys: caution is this player a higher player within D5 as for the boys. The player can be nominated but not everyone will make it. All the kids skate all the sessions.

Nominations end on Feb 8th Nominations have to come from lead coach, President or Coach in Chief. Notices will go out after Feb 14th.

What is HP and what is Tier 1, these are separate programs. Players are getting skill development in Tier 1 and games and chance to play for Nationals. Separate tryouts for each.

HP is trying to get kids to National Development camps.

Q: how do you the physical play at Bantams, most kids are not being taught body contact.

Remind coaches to clean up the game with the kids and continue to teach/practice body contact the correct way.

Q: The acceleration through the hit there is a misinterpretation on the charging penalty. Well it was not the 3 steps. **A:** Charging is charging 2 more strides to get to the player. If you cover a large amount of distance to get to a player you can call it charging. Mooney thinks we do not call it enough.

Are you trying to separate the player from the puck or the player from their head??? CEP clinics are valuable for these reasons.

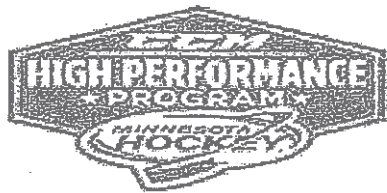

CCM High Performance 15 Information

CCM High Performance 15 Program (2002)



The purpose of the CCM High Performance Program is to identify, train, educate and evaluate Minnesota's best hockey players. The competition throughout the program gives each player the opportunity to measure themselves against others in his/her age group, gain knowledge about his/her development and to be exposed to outstanding coaching.

- **Phase 1:** Players will participate in tryouts within their Minnesota Hockey Districts. In 2017, players must have a 2002 birthdate to participate.
- **Phase 2:** The top 30 players (number can vary upon Districts) from each District will participate in a Developmental phase, with 20 from each District advancing to Phase 3.
- **Phase 3:** The District teams compete in five games, which will include three games at the CCM HP 15 Spring Festival at the Plymouth Ice Arena.
- **Phase 4:** The top 102 players from the Spring Festival will be selected to compete at the CCM High Performance Summer Festival in St. Cloud.
- **Phase 5:** The top players from the Summer Festival will be selected to the CCM HP Herb Brooks Foundation National Prep Camp in Blaine.
- **Phase 6:** Players will attend the USA Hockey HP 15 National Player Development Camp.

The Spring and Summer Festivals provide excellent opportunities for our players to be seen by junior, college, and NHL scouts. In addition, players have the opportunity to be evaluated for potential participation in national camps.

Nomination Process

The nomination process for the District 5 CCM HP 15 program is that all players **MUST** be nominated by his/her coach, association president, or association ACE coordinator.

All players selected to participate in the tryout will be notified by email. Please make sure that all email addresses are current with your local association.
