**New players and LTP players are encouraged to attend this evaluation skate.** There is no fee for this evaluation skate. Mini-Mites & Bantams **DO NOT** have an evaluation skate. Experienced players are not required to attend.

**REMEMBER:** Players “age-up” in the Spring season. Please be sure you are registering for the correct age group. It may be different than your fall/winter team.

Please register early to avoid disappointment. RHL does fill quickly. Once a level is full, a waitlist will be available.

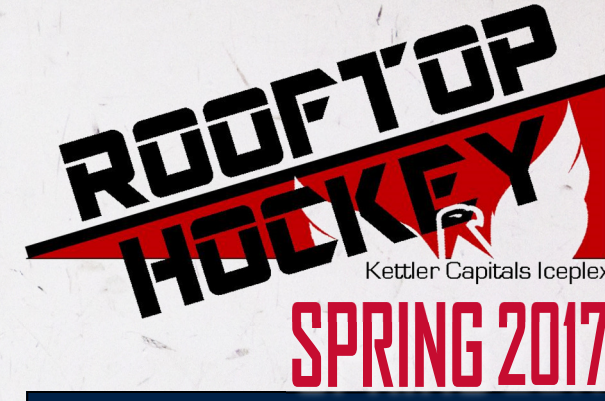
**ALL PLAYERS MUST REGISTER FOR THEIR BIRTH YEAR. NO EXCEPTIONS.**

**GOALIE REGISTRATION:** Goalie registration time period is the same as player registration. A separate GOALIE registration link is available for goalies (Squirt, Pee wee, and Bantam/Midget). **USA HOCKEY REGISTRATION**

We require all House League participants to register independently with USA Hockey at [www.USAHockeyRegistration.com](http://www.USAHockeyRegistration.com). Registration for ages 6 and under is free. Your 16-17 USA Hockey number is required when registering for RHL. You will not be able to participate in the evaluation skate or the RHL season without a 2016-2017 USA Hockey registration.

**The Spring 2017 hockey season is here!**

- **Season runs April—mid June, with evaluations taking place April 3rd (see back for details).**
- Hockey Director and RHL Coaches will evaluate and divide players into balanced teams for the season.
- REMEMBER: Players “age-up” in the Spring season. Please be sure you are registering for the **correct age group**.
- Teams are assigned after the evaluation skate. Siblings of the same age will be placed on the same team unless requested otherwise. We will NOT accept other special requests.
- Teams will be announced on our website and via email. Please confirm that we have your most recent email address when you register.
- The number of players per team is subject to change. We may increase or decrease the number of teams at a level depending on skill level and enrollment numbers.
- Team Jersey included.
- See back for **GOALIE registration information**. Goalie fees are the same as player fees.

**MINI-MITES**

Birth Years 2011, 2012

- Prerequisite: All players must have completed at least 2 sessions of Youth Learn To Play classes or previously played in Mini-Mites to register for Mini-Mites House league.
- Practices: Players will be divided into small groups and placed into stations. There will be a weekly focus on specific skills. Each station will incorporate drills for skill development and fun.
- Practices/games are on Sundays afternoons.
- 8 week session begins Sunday, April 23.
- **Cost: \$336**

**SQUIRTS**

Birth Years 2007, 2008

- Prerequisite: All players must have completed at least 2 sessions of Youth Learn To Play classes or have previously played in the house league.
- The 8 week season will include 8 games and 4 practices.
- Games are full-ice and consist of 3 minute warm-up and three 12 minute periods.
- Games will be held on Saturday afternoons beginning April 22.
- Practices will be held on Monday nights beginning April 17. Teams will alternate practices each week.
- **Cost: \$415**

**PEEWEEES**

Birth Years 2005, 2006

- Prerequisite: All players must have completed at least 2 sessions of Youth Learn To Play classes or have previously played in the house league.
- The 8 week season will include 8 games and 4 practices.
- Games are full-ice and consist of 3 minute warm-up and three 12 minute periods.
- Games will be held on Saturday afternoons beginning April 22.
- Practices will be held on Monday nights beginning April 17. Teams will alternate practices each week.
- **Cost: \$415**

**MITES**

Birth Years 2009, 2010

- Prerequisite: All players must have completed at least 2 sessions of Youth Learn To Play classes or have played in the Mini-mites or Mite house league before registering for Mites House league.
- The 8 week season will include 8 games and 4 practices.
- Games will be cross-ice with a warm-up and two 30 minute periods.
- There are no full-time goalies in Mites. Players volunteer to play goalie position and the coach will rotate goalies each game. Kettler provides goalie gear for Mites.
- Games will be held Sunday afternoons beginning April 23.
- Practices will be held on Wednesday nights beginning April 19. Teams alternate practices each week.
- **Cost: \$378**

Birth Years 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004

- Prerequisite: All players must have completed at least 2 sessions of Youth Learn To Play classes or have previously played in the house league.
- This is a **scrimmage-only** league (no practices) with 8 games.
- Games are full-ice and consist of 3 minute warm-up and three 12 minute periods.
- Games will be held on Saturday evenings
- Games begin April 22.
- **Cost: \$360**
