EXEMPTIONS -All D6 (2001- 1998) varsity wrestlers automatically qualify for the NYWAY State Championships but are highly encouraged to participate in the Regionals. D5 (2003 – 2002), and D4 (2005 – 2004) varsity wrestlers are also exempt from the regionals IF they place top 6 at NYSPHSAA High School State Championships otherwise will need to compete at the Regional and in their age group to qualify for the NYWAY State Championships. A D4/D5 wrestler who meets the said exceptions is also allowed to bump up a division. This is an aged based tournament. At the NUWAY Nationals; wrestlers will only be allowed to compete in their respective age group/division.

- ✓NYS Modified High School Rules with NYS Certified Referees.
- ✓NFHS overtime rules apply. Headgear is highly encouraged.
- ✓ Period lengths Divisions 1, 2, & 3 (1-1-1) Divisions 4, 5, & 6 (1:30, 1:30, 1:30)
- ✓Top 4 in each weight class qualify for the NYWAY Championships on March 18th and 19th at SRC Arena @ Onondaga Community College and MUST compete at same weight class at the NYWAY States. 6 full mats will be utilized.
- ✓ Welcome to all wrestlers who attend a school within the Capital Regional boundaries
- ✓ Weight classes with 5 or fewer wrestlers will wrestle in a round robin format. Weight classes' will not be combined. This is a NYWAY State Championship qualifier.
- ✓ No weight allowance and must weigh in a singlet.
- ✓ If wrestlers do not make the weight they are registered in, they will be moved to the next weight class up, and must compete at the same weight in the NYWAY State Championships.
