D2 (2009/2008): 43, 47, 51, 55, 60, 65, 70, 75, 82, 90, 98, 108, HWT (Max 120)
D3 (2007/2006): 50, 55, 60, 65, 70, 75, 80, 85, 90, 95, 105, 115, 125, HWT (Max 145)
D4 (2005/2004): 60, 65, 70, 75, 80, 85, 90, 98, 105, 113, 121, 130, 140, 155, HWT (Max 175)
D5 (2003/2002): 81, 87, 93, 99, 105, 111, 118, 125, 132, 139, 146, 153, 160, 170, 185, HWT (Max 220)
D6 (2001 - 1999): Wrestlers will be paired using the Madison Style Pairing System at the Regional Tournament, but HS weight classes will be used at the State Tournament.

EXEMPTIONS -All D6 (2001- 1998) varsity wrestlers automatically qualify for the NYWAY State Championships but are highly encouraged to participate in the Regionals. D5 (2003 - 2002), and D4 (2005 - 2004) varsity wrestlers are also exempt from the regionals IF they place top 6 at NYSPHSAA High School State Championships otherwise will need to compete at the Regional and in their age group to qualify for the NYWAY State Championships. A D4/D5 wrestler who meets the said exceptions is also allowed to bump up a division. This is an aged based tournament. At the NUWAY Nationals; wrestlers will only be allowed to compete in their respective age group/division.

2017 Regional Rules:

- ✓ All divisions are determined by birth year.
- ✓ NYS Modified High School Rules with NYS Certified Referees.
- ✓ NFHS overtime rules apply. Headgear is highly encouraged.
- ✓ Period lengths - Divisions 1, 2, & 3 (1-1-1) Divisions 4, 5, & 6 (1:30, 1:30, 1:30)
- ✓ Top 4 in each weight class qualify for the NYWAY Championships on March 18th and 19th at SRC Arena @ Onondaga Community College and **MUST** compete at same weight class at the NYWAY States. 6 full mats will be utilized.
- ✓ Welcome to all wrestlers who attend a school within the Capital Regional boundaries
- ✓ Weight classes with 5 or fewer wrestlers will wrestle in a round robin format. Weight classes' will not be combined. This is a NYWAY State Championship qualifier.
- ✓ **No weight allowance** and must weigh in a singlet.
- ✓ If wrestlers do not make the weight they are registered in, they will be moved to the next weight class up, and **must** compete at the same weight in the NYWAY State Championships.
