Committee updates

Ad Panels: 2 new ones have been obtained. Waiting to receive money on some others. Fundraising:

- \$1300 received from the Flag fundraiser. There are flags that have been sold, but Jenn has not received just yet. At this time \$650 will be donated.
- Paint-N-Sip Mom's will be provided with materials to paint one of two suggestions, one drink and appetizers.
 Room at The Mill has been donated for no cost. Suggesting cost to be \$40 per person and the Association would be receiving \$25.

- Skate with Santa Suggesting for \$10 per person. They would skate with Santa, would have an activity to do in the warming room and would also receive a personalized Christmas ornament. Bob has indicated that if we would provide with to the public (during public skate), then the City will need to be involved. Bob to call Korp to coordinate. Suggesting for December 17th.
- Shoot a Thon Suggested to go over Christmas break. There is a site called 99 Pledges. The site only takes a very small portion of the pledge for processing and leaving the association with roughly 90%.
- Kurt Parry has made some hockey lockers in the past. Rough estimate of parts would be \$150. Jenn would be
 able to customize the paint job. If we do this, an announcement prior to each of the tournaments would be sent
 to the teams. The lockers could be raffled off at tournaments.

Tournament: Silver Stick is coming, currently have 4 confirmed Bantam Teams, have number of inquiring Pee Wee teams, but none have confirmed. And at this time still looking for Squirt teams. For the house tournament in Feb. from the number of inquiries, I will more than likely capping each of divisions at no more than 6 per level. (1 Bantam division and 2 Pee Wee and Squirt divisions.

New Business

Squirt numbers. Currently there are 13 on Squirt Blue, but there is one that will not skate during games. Which give the actual numbers of skaters who play are, 12 skaters for Squirt Blue, 10 skaters for Squirt White and 13 for Squirt Red. Head Coach Dan Pylman was asked to come off the ice and into the meeting for his input. The question given to Coach Pylman was, are you for or against the Blue team moving one player up to the White team. His response was I am a little against it.

Dean makes a motion to update the numbers for Squirt White to be 11 and Squirt Blue to be 11. Julie S. seconds. For this motion vote count is: 1 for yes, 7 for no and 1 for abstain to vote. **Motion does not carry**.
