

Century Softball Lettering Guidelines

A student-athlete may earn a Varsity letter if they:

- Remain a member of the team, in good, academic standing, for the entire season. Any player who removes themselves from the team or who is otherwise removed from the team at any point during the season will not be eligible to receive a letter (this includes violations of MSHSL or CHS rules).
- Plays in 10 Varsity games
 - o Has at least 30 Varsity at bats
 - o Impacts the program in a positive way
 - Head Coach has the final say on lettering decisions
- Are a player who has been making significant contributions to the program, but sustains a softball related injury which prohibits further competition, provided she continues to attend practices and games and assist in managerial duties.
- Represent the program in a positive light, supports all levels of teams within the program (JV & C squad) and respects all coaches
 - Head Coach has the final say on lettering decisions
- Meets or exceeds expectations set forth by our coaching staff and the Minnesota State High School League
- Any athlete who is ejected from any contest throughout the season will not be eligible for lettering.
- The Head Coach reserves the right to letter athletes that meet all expectations and demonstrate the passion for the Program. (i.e Managers, injured players, etc..)

Note: Special cases that are not included above will be determined on an individual basis by the coaching staff. If a player receives a chemical violation, she will not letter.
