Hi Parents,

The Kent Knights Youth Sports Association has been working towards the goal of creating football and cheer feeder programs for our four high schools in the Kent and Covington communities for the past several years. With that, we want to thank all of you for participating in our feeder programs and doing what you can to get more kids involved.

We want to communicate to you that our organization has made the decision based on declines in enrollment and increased costs to operate the feeder program, to go back to the Kent Knights teams. The economics of these factors have forced us to temporarily abandon the feeder concept for now. This decision did not come lightly and in order to keep the Kent Knights as a valued asset to our community, this is what needs to happen at this time.

We are excited to share with you that we have joined forces with eleven other teams in the [Northwest Premier Football League](#). The season is scheduled to tentatively begin on July 17th 2017 with a regular season of eight games along with playoffs and championships.

The teams will be separated by grades; 1st-2nd, 3rd-4th, 5th-6th and 7th-8th and all teams will practice in one location to be determined. Home games will be played at French Field.

Prior to moving towards the feeder program, the Kent Knights organization has been in the Kent community since 1979 and we are excited to return to our Kent Knights roots and continue to help the youth in our communities.
