SP Ice Update

Larry has tenured his resignation as rink manager. He will not be leaving until a replacement is hired and trained. Posting of the rink manager job went out last week. There will be a greater emphasis on business practices; not so much on selling ice. SP Ice is going to be meeting twice a month rather than once a month. April activity-still planning on having some type of tournament; Alumni committee is meeting Monday night to start planning. Kiosk has been ordered for the lobby.

JV Update

Information was sent out via e-mail blast and to the reps to forward onto team. Make sure signed up for E-mail Chimp. It was the most positive discussion they have had this far. Issues involved are tightness of school budget and cuts in staffing through departments. It is a hard sell with cut in positions. They see a significant value and commitment to the students. Current estimate is \$15,000 per season; if could slash it to \$7,500 would be more favorable. Girls JV hockey was not part of the discussion earlier, but is now. Girls is Coop and SP splits the cost with the teams that are cooped and this could be an issue. Karen asked is now the time to go to school board members? Betsy indicated that yes, but should keep it positive. Now is the time because scheduling will take place in a month or so. There is a placeholder for SP junior varsity team. Should hopefully know by June.

There is a puck shortage-Suzanne will send out an e-mail to coaches to remind them that pucks should not "walk away"

President-Stacy-Stacy highlighted the joint SP Ice/SPYHA meeting held on January 31st. They are currently working with the Max Gallery software. Currently working on digital signage. There will be three TV's with locker room assignments, etc; one in the lobby, one in the entry way and one at the bottom of the ramp. The only in the lobby will include meeting rooms. There is a problem with the roof. A temporary fix has been done. Stevens will repair once it gets warmer. Zamboni's are in need of maintenance. The Tubbs rink ice will be melted in August. It was okayed to put stick holders in Tubbs area. Kohlman Cup is in April-may need volunteers. Financial status was reviewed. The pro shop is officially done; SP ice may try and do pro shop themselves with sharpening, laces, mouth guards, etc. There will now be a SP Ice contact person at every open skate. It was discussed possibly having Carinal Cups only on Saturday and Sunday; no Friday games. The only time on Saturday that ice wouldn't be available would be from 10:15-11:15. Close to our 500 volunteer hours. Discover Wisconsin may due a segment this summer from the rink which would air in 2018.

Financial commitment to JV program-The board approved to give \$15,000 to try and make this palatable. Negotiate non-prime time ice. Girls would continue to take morning ice. JV may be less time such as an hour vs an hour and a half which varsity has. Increase donation; pay up to \$10,000 for the first two years for ice. District is interested in surcharging hockey. Each sport falls into a tier. Other districts have just surcharged hockey to take the easy way out. Doing a surcharge for the first two years may be funded by fundraising. Admission being charged goes into the general fund; not back to the sport budget. Need backing of administration, but how do we get it done. Misi made a motion to add \$5,000 for a total of \$20,000 to pay \$10,000 for the first two years of ice; Carrie second it. 7 agree and 1 against.

Committee to discuss changes to the Midget program-Gary will take the lead on forming the committee. Gary would like to form a committee to see how we can keep each and every kid. He would like to get parents and players together to brainstorm some ideas and make it better. It is about the kids playing and practicing. If there is a JV team and a midget team; have to remember that the midget team wants to win also. Going to lose 10 to 11 kids because they did not make varsity or JV. Think about the kids.

Concession stand cameras-The cameras have already been approved. Misi will take the lead on getting them and getting them installed. Misi needs to know how many cameras we need and what type we need. Will probably only need 1 camera per concession stand. Some money disappeared this week from the lock box in concession stand. Larry is going to try and pull the video footage. There has been \$500 approved for cameras. SPYHA should have control of the cameras.

Other business-Misi asked for \$300 for miscellaneous for State Tournament. That is what is allotted.
