

Thunder and Lightning Safety Policy/Rule of the OVYL

If any person hears thunder or sees lightning, ALL FIELDS MUST BE EVACUATED IMMEDIATELY.

Do NOT seek shelter in the dugouts, sheds, or pavilion area because they are unsafe locations.

The only suitable shelter at the Youth League is inside the concession stand building or in a vehicle, excluding convertibles.

All fields must remain free of all persons until thirty (30) minutes after the last flash of lightning is seen or thunder is heard.

***Anyone wearing metal cleats must remove them immediately.**

***All participants must be removed from all fields and in a safe place such as a car or the concession stand. The pavilion and dugouts are not acceptable.**

MEDICAL EMERGENCY

In the event of a medical emergency apply first aid and dial 911.

AED machine is located in the hallway of the concession stand.

First Aid boxes are located throughout the Youth League in the sheds and the concession stand.
