

Parents/Guardians-

- 1. Show respect for players, coaches, board members and other parents/guardians.
- 2. Encourage players to perform to the best of their athletic ability.
- 3. Respect the integrity and judgment of game officials.
- 4. Reinforce the need to adhere to the established rules and standards of the Marlton Football program.
- 5. Model fair play, sportsmanship and proper conduct.
- 6. Reinforce the need to properly use issued equipment and report equipment problems to the coaching staff.
- 7. Inform the coaching staff of any physician's limitation placed on a player.
- 8. Reinforce the importance of attending all scheduled practices, scrimmages and games on time and ready to participate.
- 9. Remember, winning is an important goal, but not the only measure of success of the Marlton Football program.
- 10. Let the coaches do their job. Address concerns about your child or the Marlton Football Program with the head coach away from the kids.
- 11. Do not enter the field of play/practice unless instructed to do so by the coaching staff.
- 12. Smoking is not permitted at the practice or game fields.
- 13. Verbal/Physical abuse or threats toward coaches and or other parents will not be tolerated. If you violate this policy, you will be subject to both an MRC suspension and Evesham Township Law.
- 14. The parents/guardians of the player are responsible for the actions of visiting family members or friends at practices, games or any other Marlton Football sponsored events.
- 15. Coaches are permitted to stop, postpone, cancel or forfeit a game if any fans home/visiting become unruly to a degree that warrants this action. This will be solely a coach's decision.
