Season in Review

- 1010 skaters registered – All time high!
- 63 teams
- 77% of Travel Age kids participated and qualified for the SKATE program
- Over 1200 hours of Community Service completed via Teams in Service
- 46% of our Travel teams finished in the Top 3 of their D6 League
- 4 District 6 regular season Champs
- 12 Teams qualified for Region Tournament Play
- 5 Teams qualified for MN State Hockey Tournament
- 1 State Consolation Champion – 15UA Black
- 2 STATE CHAMPIONS – Jr Gold A “Warriors,” and Jr Gold 16U Blue

Rink2 FUN FACTS

- Over 2,600 cubic yards of concrete just in the footings and poured wall sections. Equivalent to a 4' wide x 4" thick sidewalk that's over 9 miles long!
- In the foundation alone there is over 350,000 lbs of rebar in the CIP walls and footings. Enough steel for over 150 cars! All this steel had to be hand placed and hand tied.
- More than 18,000 Concrete blocks make up the walls inside the building.

In the rink itself:

- Over 2 ½ miles of heating tubing beneath 5" of insulation in the floor
- 24,000 pounds of steel rebar
- 11 Miles of Cooling pipe
- 18,000 square feet of wire mesh
- 260 cubic yards of concrete – another mile of sidewalk!
- 1 ¼" of ice

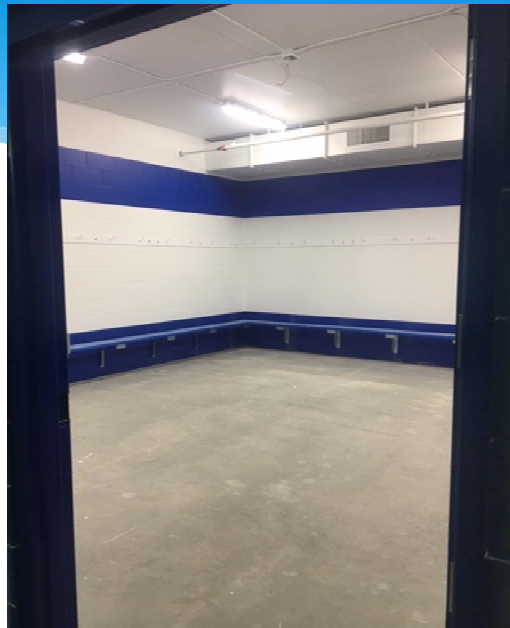
